What Makes Bad Writing Bad?

- Lack of clarity
 - Confusing phrasing, poor word choice, unclear meaning
- Poor spelling or grammar
 - Creates confusion, gets in the way of the narrative
- Poor structure/flow
 - Abrupt transitions, subject shifts confuse & drive away readers
- Too many words
 - Run-on sentences, long paragraphs are obstacles for readers
- Overinflated language
 - Direct, concise language is more effective in conveying meaning
- Passive or weak language
 - Active verbs and engaging leads keep audiences reading
